PNGOC and Trukai Industries Launch 2025 Trukai Fun Run to Support Team PNG's Pacific Mini Games Campaign

Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea – The Papua New Guinea Olympic Committee (PNGOC), in partnership with long-standing partner, Trukai Industries Limited, is excited to announce the launch of the 2025 Trukai Fun Run.

This annual event aims to raise funds for Team PNG's preparation and participation in major international competitions through the sale of Trukai Fun Run t-shirts.

Proceeds from this year's Fun Run will go towards directly supporting Team PNG's participation at the 2025 Pacific Mini Games in Palau, scheduled from June 29 to July 9, 2025.
